Luke 19:41-44 As He drew near and saw Jerusalem, He wept over her, 42. saying, "If only you had recognized this day the things that lead to shalom! But now they are hidden from your eyes. 43. For the days will come upon you when your enemies will surround you with barricades and hem you in on all sides. 44. And they will smash you to the ground—you and your children within you. 







Jesus predicts the destruction of Jerusalem


Psalms 137:1-8 By the waters of Babylon, there we sat down and wept, when we remembered Zion. 2. On the willows there we hung up our lyres. 3. For there our captors required of us songs, and our tormentors, mirth, saying, "Sing us one of the songs of Zion!" 4. How shall we sing the LORD's song in a foreign land? 5. If I forget you, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget its skill! 6. Let my tongue stick to the roof of my mouth, if I do not remember you, if I do not set Jerusalem above my highest joy! 7. Remember, O LORD, against the Edomites the day of Jerusalem, how they said, "Lay it bare, lay it bare, down to its foundations!" 8. O daughter of Babylon, doomed to be destroyed, blessed shall he be who repays you with what you have done to us!


